

- In the **Area Code Change** screen, enter the old area code in the **Old Area Code** field.
- Click the **Refresh** button.
- The **Area Code Change** screen will reload displaying all telephone number prefixes associated with the selected area code.
- Tag the prefixes that will be affected by the area code change.
- Enter the new area code in the **New Area Code** field.

Area Code Change

- Enter the value for 'Old Area Code' and Click 'Refresh' button.
- This will populate spreadsheet below with all the phone-number prefixes which are in the 'Old Area Code'.
- Tag all the prefixes which you would like to change.
- Enter value for 'New Area Code' and click 'Update' button.
